

BY-LAW NO. 1039

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF MAGRATH IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA PURSUANT TO SECTION 7 OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT TO REGULATE THE BURNING OF WASTE IN THE TOWN OF MAGRATH.

WHEREAS

Section 7 of the Municipal Government Act, RSA 1994, as amended, authorizes Council to pass by-laws respecting the safety, health and welfare of people.

AND WHEREAS

Council has deemed it necessary to regulate the burning of waste in the Town of Magrath.

NOW THEREFORE

THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MAGRATH, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, DULY ASSEMBLED, HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. This By-law may be cited as the Waste Burning By-law of the Town of Magrath.
2. No person within the boundaries of the Town of Magrath shall burn waste in a burning barrel or other such receptacle or in an open area.
3. Notwithstanding Section 2 it shall not be an offence under this section to conduct:
  - (i) Burning of clean paper and cardboard in an incinerator of a design approved by the Council of the Town of Magrath and for which a permit has been obtained from the Town.
  - (ii) Burning of yard wastes such as grass, leaves and tree branches in a safe and controlled manner during the fall and spring seasons of the year.
4. A person who contravene any provision of this By-Law is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars.
5. This By-Law comes into effect at the final passing thereof.
