

BY-LAW NO. 1042

A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF MAGRATH IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA PURSUANT TO SECTION 7 OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT TO REGULATE THE KEEPING OF LIVESTOCK AND POULTRY IN THE TOWN.

WHEREAS

Section 7 of the Municipal Government Act, RSA 1994, as amended, authorizes Council to pass by-laws respecting the keeping of wild and domestic livestock and activities in relation to them

AND WHEREAS

Council has deemed it necessary to restrict the keeping of livestock and poultry within all areas of town and for the purposes of this by-law "livestock" means cows, goats, horses, mules, donkeys, pigs, and sheep. "Poultry" means chickens, ducks, geese, turkeys and pigeons.

NOW THEREFORE

THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MAGRATH, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, DULY ASSEMBLED, HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. This By-law may be cited as the Livestock Control By-Law of the Town of Magrath.
2. A committee made up of two members of Town Council and three citizens at large shall be appointed to advise Council on matters pertaining to this by-law. This committee be known as the Livestock Advisory Committee.
3. No livestock or poultry shall be kept within the limits of the Town of Magrath without first obtaining written permission from the Council of the Town of Magrath to do so
 - (a) Written applications for permits shall be submitted annually to the Council and reviewed by the Livestock Advisory Committee.
 - (b) Permits may be revoked if the provisions of this by-law are not adhered to.
 - (c) Decisions regarding the granting or revoking of these permits may be appealed in writing to the Livestock Advisory Committee.
4. No person shall keep any livestock or poultry within that portion of the Town of Magrath designated as the "No Livestock Area" and described on Schedule "A" attached to this by-law.
5. No person shall keep any livestock or poultry within the Town of Magrath and outside the area designated as the "No Livestock" area unless a Permit has been obtained from the Council of the Town of Magrath. The number of livestock permitted shall not exceed two animals per acre.
6. No person shall construct or place any permanent animal housing structure within the limits of the Town of Magrath without first having obtained written permission from the Council of the Town of Magrath. Three sided wind shelters are exempt from this provision.
7. No person shall keep any livestock or poultry in any place used for a dwelling or in any building or shed attached thereto or connected therewith without having first obtained the permission of the Council of the Town of Magrath.
8. Notwithstanding the above Section 7, no livestock shall be kept in any building or corral situated at less distance than fifteen (15) metres from adjacent dwelling houses or less than eight (8) metres from any public street not being lane.

9. All buildings, corrals and pastures where animals are kept shall be properly constructed, ventilated, lighted and kept clean to the satisfaction of the Council of the Town of Magrath. All manure and other wastes shall be contained within the owners property in such a manner as to not be a nuisance to neighbouring properties. Any complaints in this regard shall be referred to the Livestock Advisory Committee for review.

10. No person shall keep more than twenty (20) poultry without having first obtained the written permission of the Council of the Town of Magrath. This permission will not be granted unless the premises are situated, constructed, maintained, kept and managed in accordance with the provisions of this by-law. The keeping of roosters is prohibited.

(a) The permit hereinbefore referred to shall be obtained from the Town on the first day of January in each year.

(b) All pigeons shall be confined in proper coops or wire enclosures and not allowed at large, except homers, tiplers and tumblers.

(c) The Town may order the relocation, alteration or removal of any existing sheds, coops, runways, or enclosures in which poultry are kept which do not comply with the provisions of this by-law..

11. Properties that have become non-conforming by the amendments in this by-law may continue to be non-conforming until this use is discontinued for a period of six (6) months or more at which time they must conform with the livestock control regulations then in effect.

12. Any person who contravenes the provisions of this by-law shall be liable to a fine of not less than \$50.00 and not more than \$100.00.

13. This by-law amends By-Laws #779 and #869

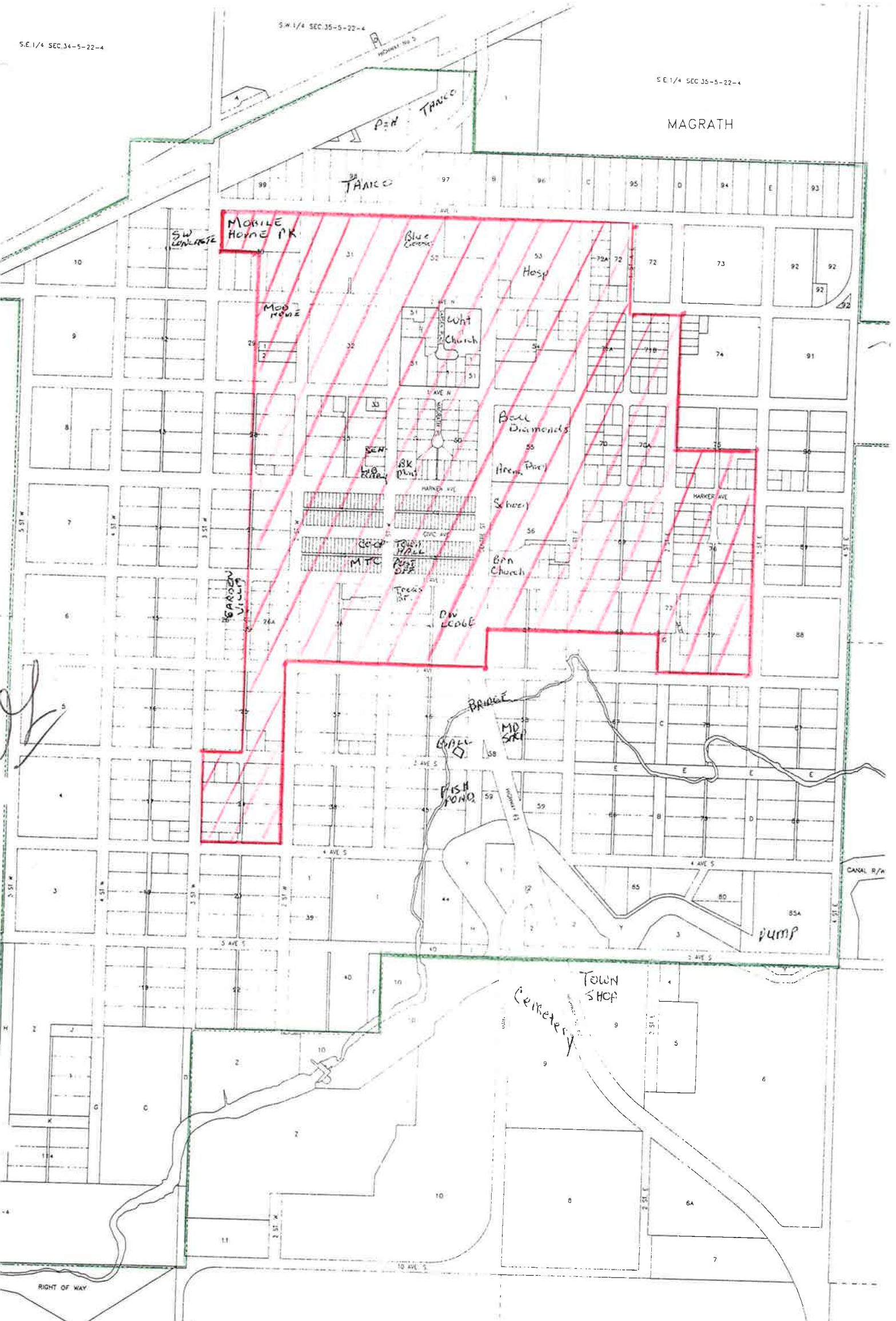
